This article will go into detail about two types of benefits in particular; Social Security Disability Insurance or SSDI, and Supplemental Security Income or SSI. Your eligibility of SSDI is dependent on your work history and disability, while SSI takes into consideration disability, as well as your income, old age or blindness.

Your social security lawyer can help you apply for SSDI if your Social Security fees are paid, and you are suffering from a physical or mental condition that prevents you from working. People who have been disabled for 12 months, anticipate being disabled for 12 months, or expect death to result from their condition can also apply for the program. Since you are eligible for the program if you expect to be disabled for a 12 month period, you do not have to wait that long before filing for benefits. There are situations wherein the Social Security office will overpay you. When that happens, and the Social Security office made the mistake, yet they ask you to return the excess amount, a social security lawyer can help you in the process of filing for a waiver. The social security lawyer can also stand in for you if you have to face a court appeal that will decide on whether you have to pay back the excess amount or not.
