

Adirondack Rentals Are Not Just For Summertime

Adirondack rentals are available in any one of several regions within the Park and in all shapes and sizes, depending on your needs. Adirondack rentals should be reserved several months ahead of time, due to the popularity of the area, but you can usually choose from a number of last minute vacancies if you make a spontaneous decision to visit the area. There are log cabins, summer camps, chalets, bed and breakfasts and lake front cottages with lake rights available on a weekly or less than weekly basis. Adirondack rentals are not limited to summertime, either. If autumn is your favorite season, come on up and enjoy the fall colors from the front porch of an Adirondack rental. If winter is your season, you know the Adirondacks have plenty to offer. You could spoil yourself with a condominium in one of the many area ski resorts.

With Adirondack rentals waiting for you at any time of the year, there is no excuse not to enjoy the many outdoor activities the region supports. During the months of spring, summer and fall you can take advantage of the many hiking and mountain biking trails, equestrian camps, lakes for boating, fishing and swimming and rushing rivers and streams for white water rafting. Wintertime, of course, offers numerous opportunities to ski (both downhill and cross country), snowshoe and ice skate.

It is difficult to say which season is the most popular. The Adirondack Park has something to offer anyone, any time of the year.
